Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *
Phthalate Bis (2-ethylhexyl) (DEHP)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *
Benzylbutylphthalate (BBP)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *
Dibutylphthalate (DBP)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *
Diisobutylphthalate (DIBP)	0.1% by weight of the homogeneous material *

* For homogeneous material is a material of uniform composition or a material made from the combination of materials, that can't be divided or separated into different materials by mechanical actions such as unscrewing, cutting, crushing, grinding and abrasive processes.
